I. God Enters Our Ruins With a _____

“Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel.” (Isaiah 7:14, NIV)

Application: Wherever you feel broken or overwhelmed, Christmas declares: *God has stepped into it with you.*

II. God Enters Our Ruins With _____

“The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; a light has dawned on those living in the land of darkness.” (Isaiah 9:2, CSB)

Application: Let His light redefine your situation — fear looks different in the light.

III. God Enters Our Ruins With _____

“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders.” (Isaiah 9:6, NIV)

Application: Invite the King into the broken places of your life. Restoration starts when surrender begins.

IV. God Enters Our Ruins in _____

The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel (which means “God with us”). (Matthew 1:23, NIV)
